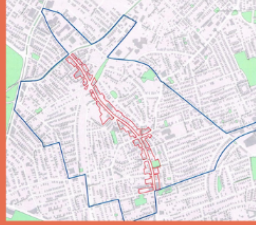
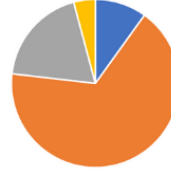


10 things every business in the Four Corners Main Street District Should Know

Four Corners has a population of 15,000 people living with 1/2 mile of our Main Street District.

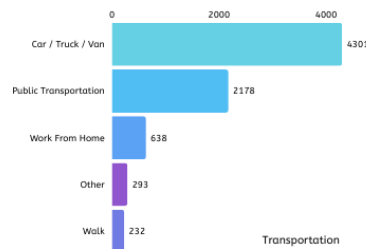


Residents are ethnically diverse. Black/African American people represent 66% of the population.

35% of Four Corners residents travel to work without a car.



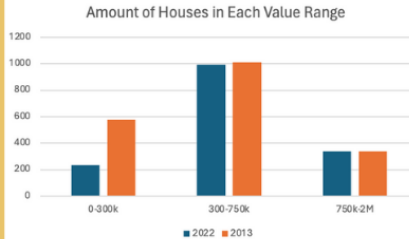
11% of Four Corners residents live in a different house than they did one year ago. 30% of these residents moved into the district from another metropolitan statistical area.



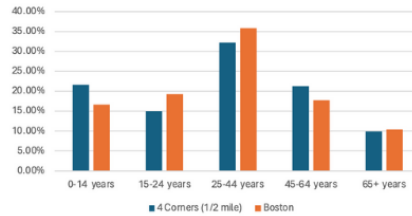
The aggregate value of housing units in the neighborhood is around 904 Million Dollars.



Most housing units are worth between \$300k and \$750k.



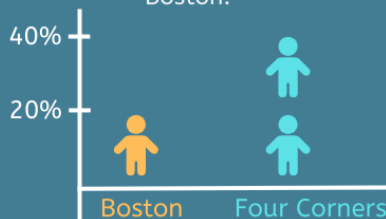
The neighborhood is young, with nearly 50% of its residents under 24 years of age



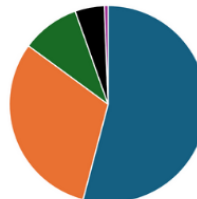
30% of Four Corners residents identify as Hispanic, up from 25% in 2010.
